RSV is a contagious virus that usually causes mild symptoms but can severely affect the lungs and respiratory airways in older adults



RSV can cause severe infections that may lead to hospitalizations in adults 60 years and older



Adults with certain underlying conditions like asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), and congestive heart failure (CHF) are also at increased risk of hospitalizations from RSV infection
